Code of Conduct

- For the safety of yourself and others, you must follow the directions given to you by your assigned supervisor.
- Emergency response is a team effort. Acting independently of the coordinated emergency response plan can be dangerous and is not permitted.
- If you find yourself in an emergency situation and have not yet been assigned to a supervisor, it is critical that your decisions and actions are based on sound judgement and the need to save and protect lives, including your own and other rescue workers.
- C.E.R.T. members are expected to act responsibly and treat all other volunteers, community members and emergency response personnel with respect.
- Failure to follow this Code of Conduct and act responsibly may result in being dismissed from duty.
